Growing the Optics Community in Southern California Pathways from education to corporate success

Abstract: The optics community in Southern California has a long and prosperous history. From the early days of the Mt. Wilson Observatory and Hollywood to the aerospace and biomedical industries, the current technical industry landscape includes almost every type of optics and photonics technology. The Southern California optics community has played a major role in developing our modern civilization.

Historically, people contributing their efforts to optics and photonic endeavors have been educated in the traditional sciences and technologies such as physics, astronomy, biology, electronics, chemistry, medicine, and photography. Today, colleges and universities are teaching optics and photonics within other departments, and a few have entire schools explicitly devoted to optical science. The pathways from education to corporate success in the Southern California optics community are stronger and clearer than ever before. Partners like Vital Link OC reach middle and high school students with STEM career exhibitions that include optics & photonics. Irvine Valley College's Photonics Technology Program educates technician-level students to have hands-on skills in photonics laboratories and manufacturing businesses. Optics and photonics businesses in Southern California have a growing number of skilled professionals to recruit. 
